At its second edition, **Contemporanea - Rome Gallery Weekend** is an initiative conceived and organized by contemporary art galleries active in the area, born with the intention of recording, mapping, and promoting the artistic ferment that characterizes the city.

"Contemporanea" isn't just any word in the recent history of culture in Rome; it evokes the famous exhibition curated in 1973 by Achille Bonito Oliva, in the underground parking lot of Villa Borghese, representing one of the most extraordinary moments, perhaps the peak, of a season of great international breadth. Beyond being a tribute to that splendid season and its protagonists, echoing this word today is above all affirming that there is a contemporary city to experience, a dense fabric to traverse; it is still about having the desire and the necessity to tell a new story.

The gallery weekend will take place from **May 10th to 12th, 2024**, with participating galleries open during extended hours: **Friday and Saturday from 11 am to 8 pm and Sunday from 12 pm to 6 pm.**
